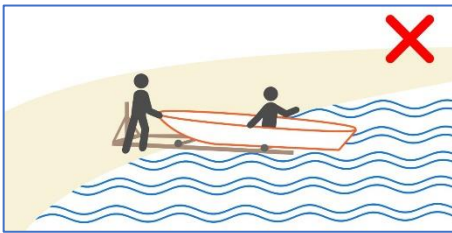
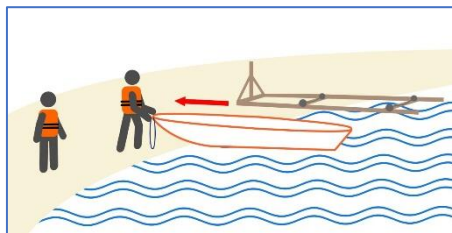
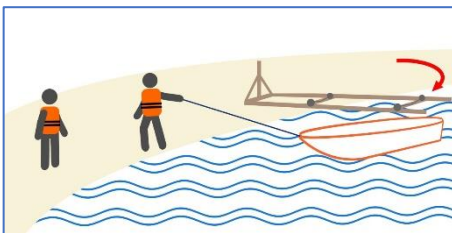


How to enjoy boating

1. Always wear **life jackets**.
2. Check if the **rainwater drain plug** is installed in the bottom of the boat. If the plug is not installed, you can find it in the scoop located at the bow of the boat.
3. Ensure that **no people are inside the boat when lowering it from the docking device**. Never lower the boat with people aboard as it poses a risk of damaging the boat and the docking rollers.



4. **Lower the boat from the docking device while holding onto the anchor rope.**
5. **Pull the boat towards the shore by the anchor rope.**
6. **Board the boat from the shore or from the pier.**



7. When boarding a boat from a pier, **do not step on the side or edge** of the boat, but place your foot closer **to the center of the bottom**.
8. **Do not sail within 50 meters of private piers and houses**, and never anchor in those areas. They are private property on the water. The owner of the dock or their neighbors have the right to photograph you and report the incident to the police.
9. **Do not leave the boat overnight at the pier**; instead, return it to the docking device. Waves can unexpectedly rise, causing the boat to collide with the pier, which could result in damage to both the boat and the pier.
10. **Parents are solely responsible for the safety of their children** while they are on the pier or on the boat.
